

Art Supply List - Mrs. Kirby 2022-2023 **Update art kits from last year

Lower School (Please note all bold information)

- Please place the following items in an art box. It can be an old lunch bag, a clear box with a lid, etc. This will help keep all art supplies together and can be carried easily. Please label it ART.
- One pack of markers, colored pencils, and crayons (You may want to send replacements after Christmas)
- Glue sticks (5)
- From Walmart: The 50-cent “Apple Barrel” paint, 2 different shades of the colors:

K-2- White, Black, and bright yellow **3-5**- light blue, gray, burgundy/ dk red

- Set of paint brushes, pencils, scissors, and erasers
- **Grade 3-5**- Set of oil pastels, soft pastels, watercolors, and 2 black sharpies
- Also each grade bring the following please: **K**- Kleenex **1st**- hand soap
2nd- Q-tips **3rd**- cotton balls **4th**- coffee filters **5th**- white or brown lunch bags

Upper School- Middle School / High School (Please note all bold information)

- Please place the following items in an art box. It can be an old lunch bag, a clear box with a lid, etc. This will help keep all art supplies together and can be carried easily. Sketchbooks may be kept in my room or lockers.
- Sketchbook- Mixed media- This will be **required in class daily!**
- Set of paint brushes
- Drawing pencils/ erasers, and scissors
- One pack of colored sharpies
- Set of oil pastels, soft pastels, and watercolors
- Black sharpies- regular, fine, and chisel tip (2 of each)
- Glue sticks (3)
- From Walmart: “Apple Barrel” paint, 2 different shades of the colors:
Middle- silver, metallic gold, brown/ tan **High School**- red, peach, navy
- Pair of white KIDS sized shoes **OR** a white hat that can be painted as their **midterm project** for Operation Christmas Shoeboxes at local churches.
- Also **each grade** bring the following please: **6th**- paper/ styrofoam plates **7th**- ziplock bags **8th**- white foam bowls **9th**- -Can of shaving cream **10th-12th**- a pack of white card stock paper

During the year, if you have any of the following items to discard, please send them to the art class.

Old magazines, newspapers, old books, discarded wood pieces, nails, bolts, screws, metal bottle caps/ corks, etc.

Scraps of wood from builders, construction sites, etc.

Scrap material, lace, felt, yarn, ribbons, glitter, any craft items, etc.

Wire, beads, discarded or broken jewelry, old buttons, discarded keys, any discarded craft items

Old gift cards, discarded picture frames with or without glass, toilet paper/ paper towel tubes

Tissue paper, decorative napkins, sponges, gift wrap tubes, bubble wrap, scrapbooking items, etc.
